
Chapter 6

Drop-Off Traffic

When the paid base lots fill, or when guests do not want to pay for parking, there is often the demand to drop off passengers at the base of the Resorts while the driver returns to look for parking. Each base lot has a specific area for dropping off passengers.

BEAR MOUNTAIN

The drop-off area at Bear Mountain is reached by using Moonridge Road. At the easterly roundabout, a sign will be placed advising approaching patrons that paid parking is available by using Moonridge Road.

The passenger drop-off area will be accessed by traveling farther around the roundabout to Moonridge Road. Drop-off traffic would turn from Moonridge Road to Goldmine Drive and enter the south lot at the westerly driveway on Goldmine Drive. A lane will be coned off to allow drop-off activities. This area will be signed for 10-minute parking.

Vehicles would exit onto Club View Drive back to a free parking lot.

SNOW SUMMIT

Drop-off traffic would approach Snow Summit on southbound Summit Boulevard and utilize the drop-off area provided in the southeast corner of the main base lot. Traffic would enter through the southerly portion of the parking lot and travel counterclockwise using the two southern parking aisles. This area would also be signed for 10-minute parking. This area would be shared with the Mountain Transit shuttles so it is important to keep these parking aisles clear.
