What is the scope of the project?

Pavement maintenance and preservation programs help to prolong the lifespan of our existing roadways. When the lifespan of a roadway has reached its limit and the structural section of a street fails, street rehabilitation and restoration practices are needed. This project includes minor concrete improvements, asphalt removal, asphalt pulverization, subsurface stabilization with cement, the repaving of 5 residential streets by city forces, and an application of cape seal on 1 residential street.

What is the project duration?

Work is scheduled to begin mid-July city wide. Hours of construction will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. We expect this project to be completed by October 1, 2019

What about parking?

"No Parking" signs with the exact date of the street rehabilitation will be posted adjacent to the areas of work at least 2 days in advance of the work. If unexpected delays occur, the new date will be posted at least 48 hours prior to the rescheduled date.

How will I be affected?

You may park your car in your driveway on scheduled days. Although streets will remain open to local traffic via measures such as traffic control and flaggers, vehicular traffic will be restricted at times during working hours. If you need off-street parking, please park on a street that does not have the parking restrictions posted.

Will there be changes to the schedule? Scheduling a project of this type may require a change in the schedule. The City and the Contractor will make every effort to minimize impacts to the community and to keep the project on schedule. The community's cooperation is greatly appreciated.

What about trash pickup or mail delivery? Services will not be affected.

We ask for the community's patience during this time and would like to advise motorists to consider alternative routes, to allow extra time for traveling, and to always "Be Work Zone Alert."
