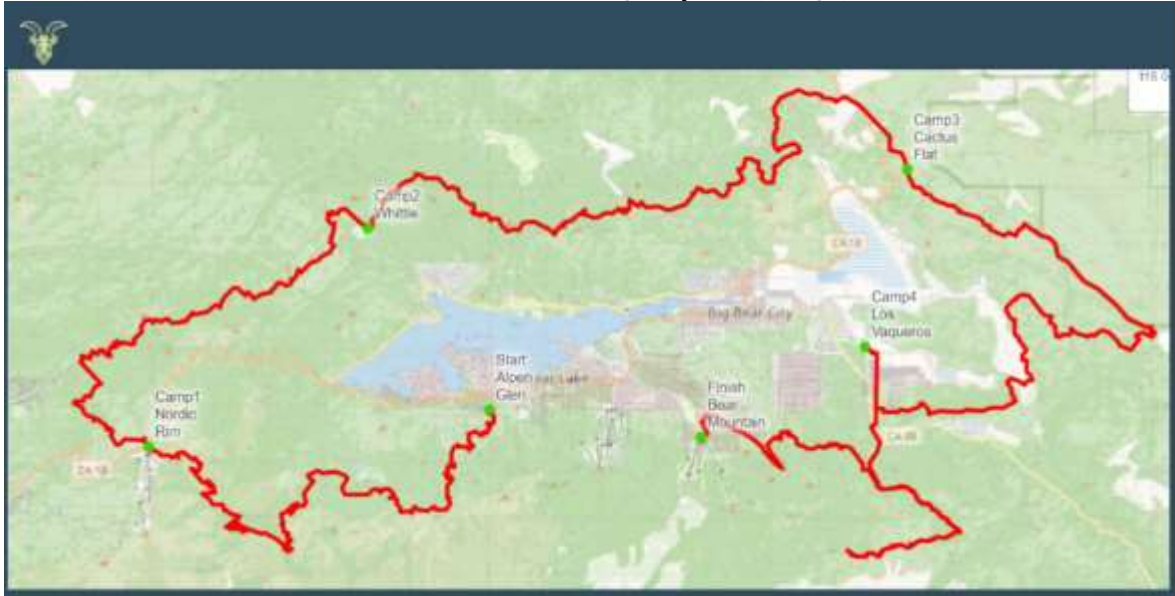




## CITY OF BIG BEAR LAKE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A PUBLIC HEARING HAS BEEN SCHEDULED BEFORE THE PLANNING COMMISSION ON WEDNESDAY, JULY 6, 2022, AT 1:15 P.M., FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE FOLLOWING ITEM:**

**Major Special Event Application 2022-043**, has been submitted by Highlander Adventure, represented by Thomas Blanc, Jurica Barac, and Ivan Zrinusic, to hold the **Highlander Adventure Big Bear Lake 2022**, an adventure hike of 60 miles, 30 miles, and 15 miles circumnavigating the Big Bear Valley. The event begins on Tuesday, September 27, 2022, and concludes on Sunday, October 2, 2022. The event headquarters, participant parking, finish line, and expo area with music, entertainment, and vendor booths will be established at Bear Mountain Ski Resort, 43101 Goldmine Drive, Assessor Parcel Number 0310-951-05. No streets or highways will be closed for the event. This application has been determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15304(e), Class 4, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).



The public hearing will be held in Hofert Hall of the City of Big Bear Lake Civic and Performing Arts Center at 39707 Big Bear Boulevard, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315. Any person may appear and be heard in support or opposition to the proposal at the time of the hearing.
