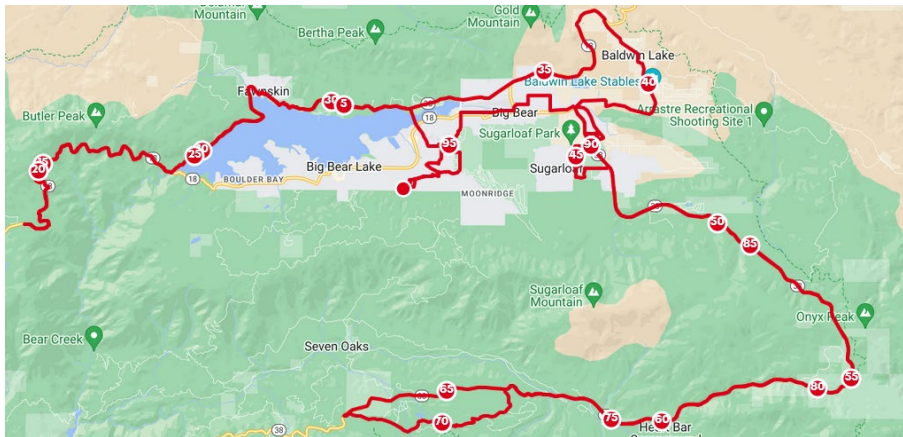




CITY OF BIG BEAR LAKE PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

THE CITY OF BIG BEAR LAKE PLANNING COMMISSION WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING AT 1:15 PM ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7, 2023, IN HOFERT HALL AT 39707 BIG BEAR BOULEVARD, BIG BEAR LAKE, CA 92315 TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING ITEM:

Major Special Event Application 2023-029, for the “Tour de Big Bear” to take place with all new route configurations and new expo location on Saturday, August 5, 2023, starting at 4:00 a.m. and concluding at approximately 5:00 p.m. This event consists of 7 different cycling stage routes that are located throughout the Big Bear Valley. An expo with the start/finish line with live music, and booths will take place at the base area of Snow Summit, 880 Summit Boulevard identified as Assessor Parcel Number’s 2328-169-01, 2328-086-27, & 28. This application has been determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15304(e), Class 4, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Related to the event but not part of the City’s approval, the event proposes a partial street closure for eastbound traffic on Northshore Dr. from Big Bear Dam to Stanfield Cutoff for cyclist and driver’s safety. Westbound traffic on Northshore Dr. will remain open to local traffic only. Additional City and County streets will be used, but not closed.

Any person may appear and be heard in support or opposition to the proposal at the time of the hearing. Notification 72 hours prior to the hearing will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements to ensure accessibility. Written comments should be directed to the Planning Division, PO Box 10000, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315, and must be received prior to the hearing

date to be included in the public record. If you challenge the above action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues which you or someone else raised at the hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the meeting.
