NOTICE OF A MAJOR SPECIAL EVENT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A PUBLIC HEARING HAS BEEN SCHEDULED BEFORE THE PLANNING COMMISSION ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2022, AT 1:15 P.M., FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE FOLLOWING ITEM:

Major Special Event Application 2022-020, submitted by Mason Perry, requesting to postpone the Goldmine Music Festival, originally proposed for Saturday, September 17, 2022, to **Saturday, September 16, 2023**. Major Special Event application 2022-020 was considered by the Planning Commission on May 18, 2022, and approved by the adoption of Resolution No. PC2022-09. The event remains as originally proposed with the exception of the event date. The event consists of a live outdoor music concert from 2 pm to 9 pm to be held at the former Big Bear Elementary School, 40940 Pennsylvania Avenue (APN 0309-111-01) and a festival area and beer garden from noon to 9 pm in the Knickerbocker Road public parking lot, 630 Knickerbocker Road, (APN's 0308-174-24, 29, 40 & 41). Knickerbocker Road between Pedder Road and Village Drive will be closed to vehicular traffic to accommodate pedestrian circulation between the two venues. The school property is zoned Public/Open Space (P-OS) and the public parking lot is zoned Village Specific Plan Neighborhood Commercial (VSP-NC). The project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15304, Class 4, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The public hearing will be held in Hofert Hall of the City of Big Bear Lake Civic and Performing Arts Center at 39707 Big Bear Boulevard, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315. Any person may appear and be heard in support or opposition to the proposal at the time of the hearing.
